



## 2018-2019 AAUW MN TECH SAVVY GRANT

AAUW has a long history of taking action to increase women's and girls' opportunities and interest in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) from the classroom to Capitol Hill. In support of the AAUW mission of advancing equity for women and girls through advocacy, education, philanthropy and research, AAUW developed the Tech Savvy conference. The purpose of the conference is to encourage girls to participate in STEM related activities and inform parents about STEM education and careers.

AAUW MN supports the AAUW Tech Savvy program which is one of the multipronged approaches to close the gender pay gap. **The State Board voted to approve \$7,500 for competitive grants for 2018-2019 for a branch, working collaboratively, to host an AAUW Tech Savvy Conference. We will fund both small and large projects. The maximum amount for a large project will be \$2,500.**

Information and applications will be sent to each branch president on May 3, 2018.

**Applications for the Tech Savvy grant are due August 20, 2018. Recipients will be notified by September 4, 2018.** The recipients will be recognized at the 2019 state convention. AAUW MN anticipates that the Tech Savvy Conference will be completed by August 1, 2019.

To better understand what is expected in a Tech Savvy conference, it is recommended reading the AAUW, "How to Host a STEM Program in Your Community" and "STEMpack: Host an AAUW Tech Savvy".
