The MN State Board supports the AAUW charge to close the gender pay gap with a multipronged approach to a complex problem. The AAUW WORK Smart innovative curriculum is grounded in the latest research and offers the best practices for navigating the complexities of job offer.

The State Board has voted to approve three competitive grants of \$1,500 each for 2018-2019 for branches to host **either** an AAUW Smart Start or an AAUW Work Smart workshop.

AAUW Work Smart was created for working women. It is a two hour workshop designed to help working women negotiate for a new job, a raise, benefits or a promotion.

Successful workshops have been done in collaboration with city and state government agencies, local professional women's organization, community organizations, alumni associations, companies and employee resource groups.

Applications will be available by May 4, 2018 and will be due by August 20, 2018. The recipient branch will be notified by September 4, 2018. The branch will be recognized at the 2019 convention. AAUW anticipates the Work Smart workshop will be complete by August 1, 2019.
