Session A: “From Minnesota to the End of the Earths”

Cathy Davies is the only woman rider, among 12 motorcyclists, riding around the world and talking with the women she meets. Cathy will reveal what they're saying about issues affecting women. And, Cathy will provide introspection about the role of women in the 321 countries in which she's ridden.

Session B: “Funerals, Food and Toilets: A Humorous Look at a Woman’s Place in the World”

Melissa Scaia, Director of International Training for Global Rights for Women, will talk about the place of women in the world from a unique perspective.

Session C: “You Don’t Look Like A Veteran”

Chris Magnusson, Sergeant, US Marine Corps Veteran, identifies the challenges women veterans face, from being invisible, to employment and housing, and relative to MST and PTSD. Minnesota is home to 29,000 women veterans who served in all branches of the military, times, and places.
